

## **Admission to the Doctor of Philosophy and Doctor of Sciences Programmes for non-citizens and foreigners.**

1. Education of non-citizens and foreigners in the Ph.D. and Dr.Sc. programmes is carried out on the basis of availability of funding from legal entities and individuals (contract-based on condition that the university possesses a corresponding license). On the scientific level of higher education, preparation in the Doctor of Sciences programme is carried out without obtaining such a license.

2. Admission to the Doctor of Sciences programme with the goal of preparing a dissertation to obtain a Dr.Sc. degree is carried out taking into account the scientific and scientific-technical accomplishments of the applicant according to the chosen discipline and specialization as well as according to the requirements stated in these provisions.

3. The study of foreign citizens is carried out on both full-time and part-time basis.

Foreign citizens are accepted by the university to study in the accredited academic programs:

- within the course of the year to study in the Ph.D. or the Dr.Sc. program on the basis of the documents submitted and the interview pertaining to the chosen subject and the language of instruction.

In order to be admitted into an institution of higher education a foreign citizen is required to submit a hard copy of the application in person.

The application submitted by a foreign citizen has to be supplemented with the following:

1) a document verifying an academic (academic-qualificational) level, obtained earlier, which serves as the basis for admission (both an original and a copy);

2) an official grade transcript (and a copy), if available, that supplements the document serving as proof of a previous academic (academic-qualificational) level, obtained earlier, which serves as the basis for admission.

3) an academic note, issued by a foreign or Ukrainian academic institution (in case of transferring to a different institution or in case of reinstatement in the program).

4) an original and a copy of a document that contain information about the contents of the academic program at the previous level of higher education obtained by an applicant.

5) a copy of a foreign passport or a document verifying the non-citizen status of an applicant.

6) medical insurance policy, unless otherwise agreed upon and as stated in Ukrainian international agreements.

7) 4 photographs, 30x40 mm;

8) a copy of an international passport in case an applicant is a Ukrainian citizen;

9) an applicant's research proposal in the chosen scientific discipline or a list of an applicant's published academic papers and inventions certified according to a pre-specified procedure carried out at the main place of employment are also provided in Ukrainian at the time of applying to a Ph.D. programme.

In order to apply to a Doctoral programme, the following are also provided in Ukrainian or in English;

- a doctoral dissertation proposal as part of the process of pursuing a Doctor of Sciences degree.

- a copy of a diploma certifying the award of a corresponding scientific degree.

4. Foreigners who apply to study as part of the programs of academic mobility, must provide documents, approved according to the rules of admission to an institution of higher education and/or presupposed by the requirements of international programs and/or agreements, that delimit the realization of the program of academic mobility.

The documents indicated in 1-5 above must be translated into Ukrainian with the translation being legally notarized.

The documents indicated in 1-4 above must be certified in the countries where they were issued according to the procedure that is officially employed in this country for the purposes of such a certification procedure and legalized by a corresponding international institution of Ukraine, unless otherwise indicated in Ukrainian international agreements.

5. Admission of foreigners to study according to the Ukrainian international agreements and state programs is carried out on the basis of a directive from a Ministry of Education and Science according to a procedure that is determined by these agreements and programs.

6. The documents verifying the level of education of the foreigners admitted for a course of study, which are issued by academic institutions of other countries, must go through the procedure of being verified and acknowledged in Ukraine according to Ukrainian laws.
