If your first language is not Ukrainian, you have to prove proficiency in Ukrainian before admission.

International

General Requirements for all Undergraduate Programmes

Certificate of Complete General Secondary Education (*Атестат про повну загальну середню освіту*) as well as Independent External Examination (*Зовнішнє незалежне оцінювання*) marks are required for admission to all programs. If you have completed more than 18 credit units of transferable credit units from an accredited post-secondary institution, your admission will be based on your postsecondary studies.

In order to be admitted into an institution of higher education a foreign citizen is required to submit a hard copy of the application in person.

The application submitted by a foreign citizen has to be supplemented with the following:

- 1) an application form, provided on the website of the University:
- 2) a document verifying an academic (academic-qualificational) level, obtained earlier, which serves as the basis for admission (both an original and a copy);
- 3) an official grade transcript (and a copy), if available, that supplements the document serving as proof of a previous academic (academic-qualificational) level, obtained earlier, which serves as the basis for admission.
- 4) an academic note, issued by a foreign or Ukrainian academic institution (in case of transferring to a different institution or in case of reinstatement in the program).
- 5) an original and a copy of a document that contain information about the contents of the academic program at the previous level of higher education obtained by an applicant for admission to graduate programs.
 - 6) a copy of a foreign passport or a document verifying the non-citizen status of an applicant.
- 7) medical insurance policy, unless otherwise agreed upon and as stated in Ukrainian international agreements.
 - 8) 4 photographs, 30x40 mm;
 - 9) a copy of an international passport in case an applicant is a Ukrainian citizen;

In order to apply to an Undergraduate or Graduate programme, the above mentioned documents must be translated into Ukrainian with the translation being legally notarized.

Admission of foreigners to study according to the Ukrainian international agreements and state programs is carried out on the basis of a directive from a Ministry of Education and Science according to a procedure that is determined by these agreements and programs.

The Admission Board carries out the calculation of points/grades for each applicant based on the previous academic (academic-qualificational) level and defines the necessary competitive average, necessary for a determined programme.
